Paws for Thought

Many of the common problems that beset the domesticated cat develop as a direct result of incorrect feeding, lack of mental stimulation, insufficient exercise, a lack of freedom to behave as a cat, overuse of medication, vaccination, and irresponsible breeding.

Recent scientific research has determined that domestic cats can trace their origins back to the Middle East's 'Fertile Crescent'. Scientists have compared their DNA and found that our modern day companions are related to the wild felines of the Middle East. Researchers believe that the ancestors of our modern day 'moggy' broke away from their wild relatives and started associating with humans as long as 130,000 years ago, when they were attracted to human settlements by the rodents infesting these first habitations. Certainly these ancient farmers would have found the ferocious hunting skills of these effective predators very helpful in protecting their grain.

Centuries on, the descendants of those early domesticated cats still retain many of those instincts handed down to them from their wild ancestors, such as the natural ability to stalk, hunt, and seek out various plants to help them stay fit and healthy.

This behaviour can be seen in our domesticated companions who, if given the chance, will chew on the various plants and grasses they find in our gardens. By doing this cats are responding to a natural instinct to seek out plants that will act either as emetics (encouraging vomiting) or purgatives. Tigers, if heavily infested with worms, have been seen to eat large quantities of grass, and rough grass can help cats regurgitate fur balls or assist in scouring the gut of parasites. It is thought that behaviours such as wool-chewing seen in Siamese cats or house plant chewing has a link with self-medication. Most cat owners will be familiar with the plant Catnip (many of the commercially available toys

contain this herb), which cats love to roll in and which causes them to salivate with satisfaction. However this may not be the only reason our cats are so fond of the plant, they may also be drawn to it because of its other beneficial properties. Catnip (*Nepeta cataria*) contains nepetalactone (this is the volatile oil component of the plant), and is not only responsible for attracting the cat, but also for the plants insecticidal and pesticidal actions. Joy Adamson author of "Born Free" noted that her orphaned leopard used to roll in the African equivalent of Catnip (*Leonotis nepetifolia*)* so perhaps this big sister of our domesticated cats also instinctively knew the herb's properties!

At Hilton Herbs we believe that by using the appropriate herbal supplements in conjunction with a suitable diet and environment, exercise, play, and mental stimulation we can enhance and support our cats' health. Herbs can reconnect them to their origins, giving them the power to maintain their health as their wild cousins do.

Fair Trade, Ethical values and Sustainability of raw materials

We are extremely conscious of our responsibility to ensure that the materials we use in the manufacture of our products should not have an adverse impact on the environment, the lives of people harvesting our herbs, or the sustainability of the herbs themselves.

To this end we use only bio-degradable or recyclable packaging material, and we do not use herbs that are endangered or appear on the CITES list. We support Fair Trade organisations, helping them to achieve their goals, and only purchase our herbs from sustainable sources. We do not use animal by-products, fillers, or additives, in any of our products. The majority of our herbs are cultivated crops, grown without the use of pesticides or herbicides, dried naturally, and produced by families who have been growing medicinal plants for generations.

Quality Assurance

You can be sure your cat is getting the very best ingredients, backed up by a Quality Assurance scheme second –to–none. At Hilton Herbs we operate a European-wide Quality Assurance scheme that ensures strict manufacturing procedures and controls to ensure full traceability of every single ingredient back to source.

We only buy our herbs from approved suppliers who operate the same QA system as ourselves and in order to ensure these exacting standards are both met and maintained, our company is accredited and externally audited each year by the European Feed Safety Inspection Service (EFSIS), www.efsis.com, an independent organisation who operate the Universal Feed Assurance Scheme (UFAS).

NASC – National Animal Supplements Council

In the United States, Hilton Herbs is a member of the NASC, an industry group dedicated to protecting and enhancing the health of companion animals and horses throughout the USA. The NASC membership is made up of animal supplements manufacturers,

committed to the highest standards of quality in the industry. Their website address is www.nasc.cc.

The NASC is unique in that it requires its member manufacturers to declare all product ingredients and to complete a monthly National Adverse Event Reporting System (NAERS). This system requires all member companies to report and investigate any adverse reactions reported by customers. In 2007 these systems enabled the organisation to respond quickly to enquiries from the FDA during the pet food recall when contaminated ingredients were found in many of the major commercial dog and cat foods.

The Hilton Herbs manufacturing plant has been audited by the NASC and is proud to have been awarded the organisation's 'Seal of Quality', with a A* compliance rating and we are the only UK company to have successfully achieved this accolade.

At Hilton Herbs we use only the very best quality ingredients, in fact all of our herbal formulations, both dry and liquid, are made from human medicine grade herbs.

Hilary Self BSc MNIMH who, with her husband Tony, founded Hilton Herbs in 1990, is responsible for the formulation and research of all our products. We believe we are unique in being the only herbal company for animals whose products are formulated by a qualified

Medical Herbalist, and member of the National Institute of Medical Herbalists.

Hilary uses her in-depth knowledge of the latest scientific herbal research and combines it with her own experience of the everyday problems that can affect our pets, be they physical or psychological.

Hilary is a regular speaker at veterinary seminars around the world, and has run workshops on the application of herbs for companion animals. She runs her own human herbal practice at our premises in Somerset and continues to research the application of herbs for both animals and humans.

Feline Liquid Products

Dosage guide Give 4 drops per 2.2lb (1 kg) bodyweight twice daily

All our feline herbal products are provided in a liquid format for ease of use. They are made from a combination of the highest quality 1:3 pure herbal extracts which are then added to pure vegetable glycerine. This formulation produces an almost nectar sweet liquid that most cats will find very palatable.

If possible try and give the herbs on an empty stomach, preferably at least thirty minutes before or after your cat has eaten. By feeding the herbs on an empty stomach, and not mixing them with their usual food, they will be more quickly assimilated into the cats system. The products are designed to be squirted directly into your cat's mouth. If however your cat is not happy to let you do this then they can be added to a small amount of meat stock, tuna juice, or given with any particular treat your cat loves. Failing this try dropping the liquid directly onto your cat's paws which they can then lick off.

Storage

Although our products are packed in dark coloured bottles to help protect the product, we always recommend storing them in a cool place out of direct sunlight.

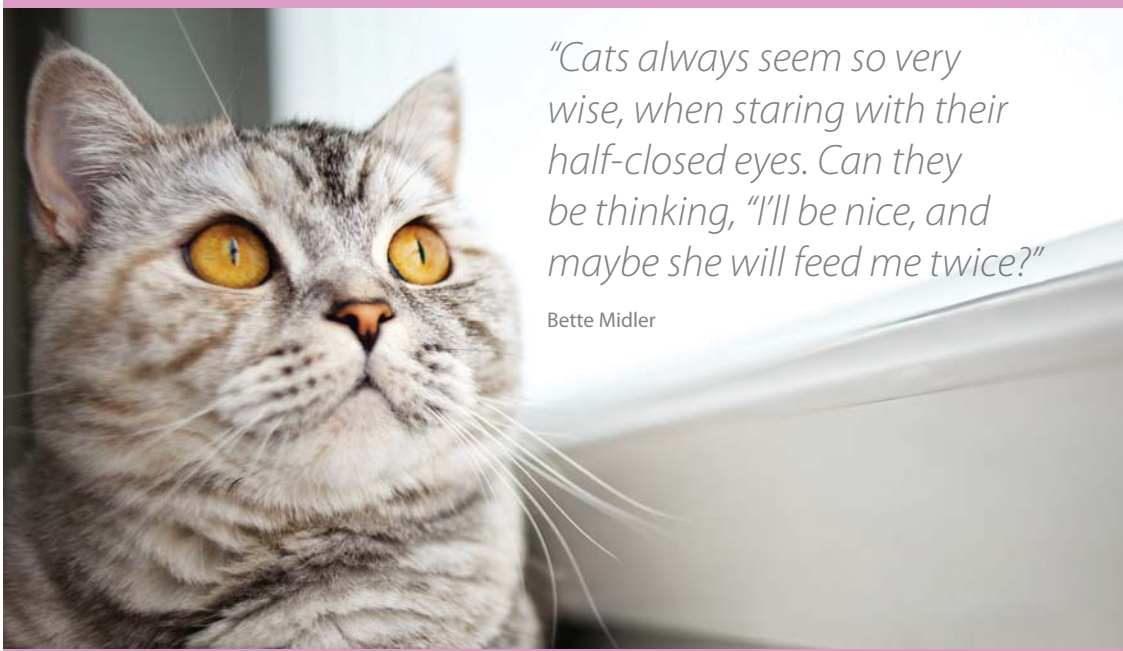

At Hilton Herbs we are keen advocates of a healthy natural diet for all our pets. Good quality food, reduction of stress, and a more natural environment is intrinsically linked to good health in our companions. Some of our pets may spend the majority of their lives outside, whilst other ‘house cats’ may rarely if ever venture outside the confines of their homes.

Our own farm cat, Blot, is now twelve years old and spends much of her time keeping our Helpline ladies company in the office. Cats are carnivorous and their digestive systems are designed to thrive on meat and not cereals, however the increased use of dried foods containing high levels of processed cereals, salt, colourings and additives, has been linked to an increase in both urinary and digestive disorders in cats. Blot’s diet is extremely varied and includes raw chicken wings, raw minced beef, and wet cat food, along with a constant supply of ‘extras’ that she finds for herself around the farm such as mice, voles, shrews, birds, and even young rabbits!

Catching this small prey is vital on many levels. It satisfies her hunting and predatory instincts, provides her with an additional protein source, and contains small bones that will help keep her teeth and gums healthy when she crunches them up. The bones then go on to provide the roughage and fibre needed to keep her digestive system healthy.

We appreciate that not all cats live in this environment, some may spend their whole lives within the house, but you can help to re-create this more natural diet by offering ‘wet’ food, raw chicken wings, fresh beef, chicken or fish, and ensuring your cat has a constant supply of fluids he or she likes such as ‘fresh water’ along with stocks or broths from your own kitchen.

By keeping their diet as natural as possible, and introducing play behavior that mimics the hunting instincts your cat would employ if it was outside in the wide world, you can help keep your cat fit and healthy both physically and mentally.

“You are what you eat”, and this old saying applies to our cats as well as ourselves. In recent years there has been an increasing trend towards the use of dry convenience foods. This may help us in our busy lives but seldom satisfies the cat’s requirements. We advocate the use of as natural a diet as possible, utilising fresh meat, fish, vegetables, and access to fresh water. We have already identified that left to their own devices many cats will seek out plants and herbs to help deal with digestive upsets. Obviously herbs alone cannot rectify the effects of a poor diet, lack of exercise, obesity, or more serious health issues, and if you have any concerns about your pet’s health you should seek Veterinary advice immediately. However by using herbs as part of your pet’s diet you can help support a healthy digestive system from top to bottom.
